HEAVY HIGHWAY AND RAILROAD CARPENTERS JOINT APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING PROGRAM

TIMELINE FOR 2024 CLASSES Applications are accepted year-round. Application deadline for the first class is March 1, 2024. Training begins in April 1, 2024. Additional classes may be held according to workforce needs.

HOW TO APPLY You must first register to attend an information session at kmliap.org. After registering and attending the information session, you will receive an application code and further instructions for applying to the program. Information Sessions are scheduled on an as needed basis by the Local Union Apprenticeship Committee. Visit kmltf.org for more information.

APPLICANT SELECTION Selection is based on the needs within the region of Western Pennsylvania. Candidates will be selected by an independent organization or appointed panel using job-related testings and interview. This program offers an excellent training opportunity, it does not guarantee full employment. Employment is assigned by the Union as provided for in the collective bargaining agreements.

Qualification Requirements of the Program Include:

- Applicants must be not less than 17 years of age, 18 to go to work
- Be physically capable of performing the work of the Heavy Highway Carpenter
- Pass a Drug Test
- Be a citizen of the United States or a Legal Alien
- Have a high school diploma, GED and furnish a transcript of high school courses and grades
- Have a valid photo government issued ID and have dependable transportation. Must be willing to travel from one job to another, regardless of the distance involved with the 33 county area
